Pulp Clamp - There is a wide range of lift truck accessories obtainable to be able to make the machinery more helpful. A snowplow accessory can be mounted to the front of the lift truck. A scoop bucket can be useful if the job requires transferring sand, gravel, soil or snow. A double block handler allows the forklift operator to pick up a couple of loads and after that pile them side-by-side. A lot of those attachments are really great for light to medium tasks.

Among the forklift attachments, called a package lift clamp, allows for the transferring and carrying of really heavy pallets. Pallet crane forks are also used so as to transfer and carry pallets by using an overhead crane. A drum clamp accessory is useful for transporting heavy drums from place to place without having to make use of a pallet. Lift truck mounted hoppers allow material to be moved and dumped without having to handle it by hand. These hoppers are self dumping when the bumper is released.

Available accessories now include accessories which allow a lift truck to perform the task of a commercial mop or broom. Such particular accessories are most often utilized cleaning parking areas, warehouse floors, and boat docks. Lift truck mounted platforms come equipped with dual entry doors and could be attached so as to transport personnel from one locale to another. The mounted platform accessory is great for reaching parts which could be difficult to access, especially when you've got goods or stuff stored in out of the way places or really up high.

Attachments can be a very valuable piece of equipment when put in a lift truck, changing a usual forklift into a mobile hoist unit. It's most helpful when moving unsteady or tricky loads. This attachment could either be mounted on the carriage itself, telescopic, or be connected or even forklift mounted.
