This includes disassembling the forklift, rebuilding the engine, sandblasting the lift and afterward reassembling the whole thing and finishing with a fresh coat of paint.

To thoroughly reconstruct a lift truck engine, a good business will first completely disassemble it. A heat cleaning system is then utilized to clean all of the parts. Once this step has been completed, all of the parts are checked to see if they have any breakage, any extensive wear or any defects. Particular components like for example connecting rods, cylinder heads, crankshafts and cylinder blocks are reground, resurfaced and resized if needed. Several components like for instance bolts, gears, nuts et cetera. are repaired or replaced as considered necessary.

When the overhaul has been done, the engine is rebuilt by hand. After being reassembled, a series of tests are applied to the working machinery in order to check all of the parts and be certain there are no leaks or issues. If any problems occur, the needed adjustments are made.
